Year 4 children will be having their second week of swimming sessions at Knowsley Leisure and Culture Park. Children do not swim on a Friday.

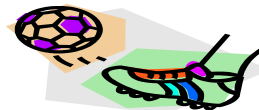


CONTACT DETAILS
