Year 3 History Coverage:

Prehistoric Britain

- changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

Early Civilisations and Ancient Egypt

- the achievements of the earliest civilizations – an overview of where and when the first civilizations appeared and a depth study of one of the following: Ancient Sumer; The Indus Valley; Ancient Egypt; The Shang Dynasty of Ancient China.

Year 4 History Coverage:

Invaders and Settlers Romans

- the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.

Ancient Greece

- a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.

Year 5 History Coverage:

The Mayans

- a non-European society that provides contrasts with British history - Mayan civilization.

Local History
