YEAR 3 CLASS ASSEMBLY

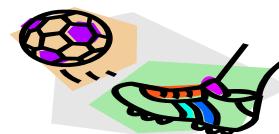
Children from our Year 3 Class will be leading an assembly about their Come and See topic "Listening & Sharing" on:-
