

ST JOSEPH'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

To instil a sense of pride and unity at St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School the following school uniform is required to be worn:

BOYS: (ALL YEAR ROUND)

Grey shorts

White shirt

Grey v necked jumper or v necked tank top

Black shoes (no trainers)

Plain grey socks

Purple and gold stripped school tie (which can be purchased from Top Form (NW) Limited, Unit 22, Sinclair Way, Prescot Business Park, Knowsley, Merseyside, L34 1PB or from the school office.

(Please note, children may wear plain grey jumpers or cardigans, they do not have to have the school badge. This allows parents to purchase items from a wide choice of retailers e.g. Asda, Tesco, M&S, etc.)

GIRLS: Winter uniform

Grey skirt or pinafore (knee length) or culottes

White shirt / blouse

Grey v necked jumper / cardigan

Grey socks / tights

Black shoes (no trainers)

Purple and gold striped school tie (which can be purchased from Top Form (NW) Limited, Unit 22, Sinclair Way, Prescot Business Park, Knowsley, Merseyside, L34 1PB or from the school office.

GIRLS: Summer Uniform (optional - winter uniform can be worn throughout the year)

Blue gingham dress (no play suits)

Grey cardigan

White socks

Black shoes (no trainers)

P.E. KIT

Black pumps,

Black shorts,

White t-shirt / white polo shirt.

Children should come to school on their PE days dressed for PE. Children can come to school in a pair of plain black trainers or their school shoes and bring their pumps in a pump bag so they can change for PE.

In the winter months the children can wear plain black tracksuit bottoms or leggings.

Key Stage 2 classes attend swimming lessons on a rota basis.

Swimming - Trunks (no shorts with pockets) /costume (no bikinis)

Towel

Swimming cap

ALL UNIFORM ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED

PERSONAL PROPERTY

All items of clothing and other personal property brought into school should be clearly marked with the child's name and class.

Please note that neither the school nor the Local Authority has insurance to cover your child's property in the event of it being lost or stolen.

MOBILE PHONES

Children are not allowed to bring mobile phones into school. Any mobile phones accidently bought into schools will be looked after by the teacher until an adult can collect them.

JEWELLERY

In the interests of health and safety, children are not permitted to wear any jewellery in school, apart from an inexpensive watch (no apple watches or fit bits allowed) and small stud earrings (which will need to be removed for PE).

Hair should be neat and appropriate - no extreme haircuts or colours through the hair. Long hair should be tied back, with bobbles / ribbons in school colours. Flowers and other decorations should not be worn for school - they should be saved for 'non- uniform days'.

LOST PROPERTY

Please contact your child's class teacher in the first instance. Lost property is located in classrooms. Items will be kept for a term only.
