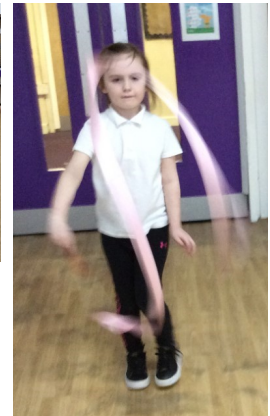
First Communion Sessions

To complete our celebrations of this years Chinese New Year on Sunday 22nd January, the children in Year 1, 2,3 and 4 all took part in some dance workshops.

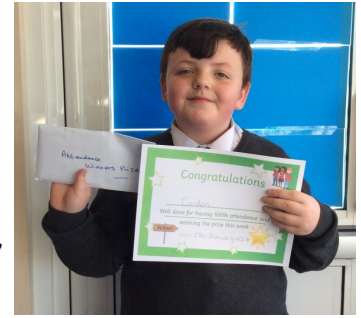


100% Attendance Winner
