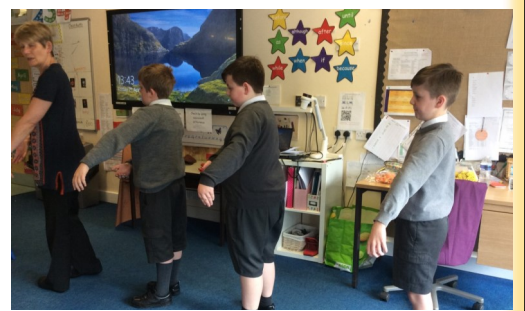


### Coronation Disco
