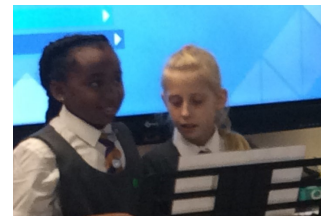
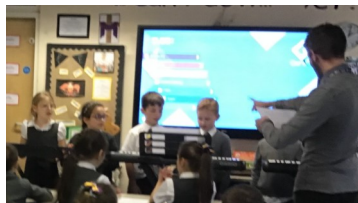
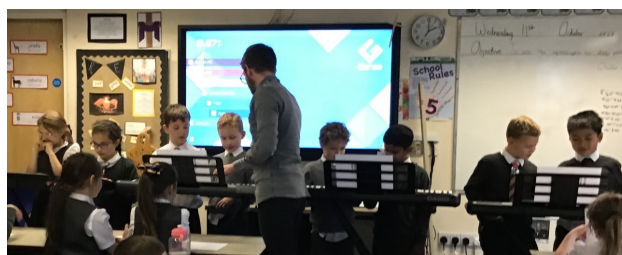
Cross country
