100% Attendance Winner

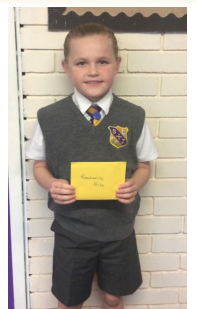

100% Punctuality Winner

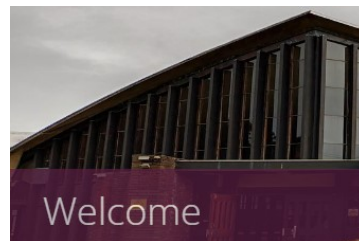

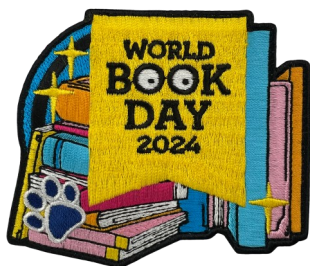


Y4 Class Mass
