100% Attendance Winner

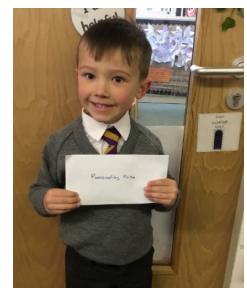
