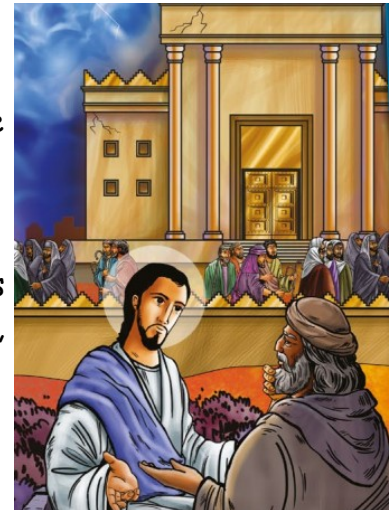


Our RE topic is : Advent / Christmas (Loving)
