To mark Remembrance day this Year 5 will lay a wreath at the Huyton Cenotaph in a sign of respect for those who have died in conflict.

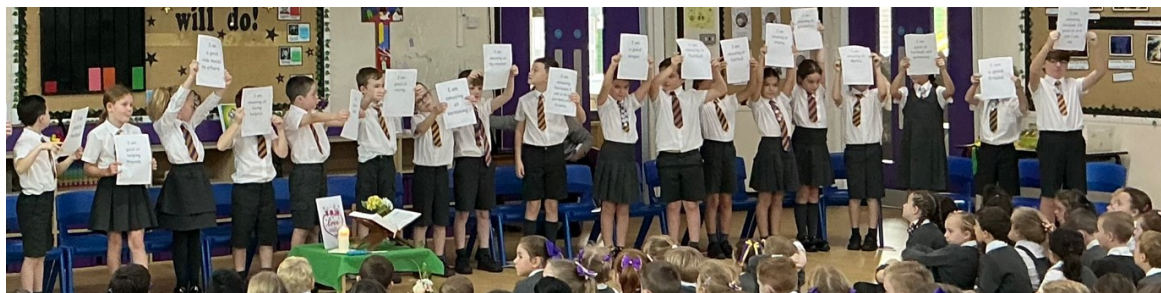


Football Match
